

USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY
EXCEPT WHERE LOCAL RULES PREVAIL

1. Lateral Water Hazards: All water hazards are played as Lateral Water Hazards and are marked with red stakes or lines.
2. Out-of-Bounds: Out-of-Bounds is defined by white stakes, lines, retaining walls and curbing on streets. All areas beyond the marked points are Out-of-Bounds and prohibited from play.
3. Embedded Ball: Through the green, a ball that is embedded in its own pitch mark in the ground, other than sand, may be lifted without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to where it lay, but not nearer the hole.
4. Obstructions: Obstructions are anything artificial, including cart paths, pump houses, water control boxes, irrigation heads and buildings. If a ball lies on or off the putting green but not in a hazard and an immovable obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take free relief.
5. Tree basins that are artificially lined, sunken or built-up with raised lips for irrigation are ground under repair; relief may be taken without penalty.
6. Sprinkler heads are measured to the center of the green.
7. Providing Relief from Bird or Animal Dung: (Modified Rule 23 Loose Impediments) Bird/animal dung through the green is played as a loose impediment and may be removed without penalty. In the event that bird or animal dung becomes adhered to the ball, the player may take relief, without penalty, by marking, lifting, cleaning, and placing the ball at the nearest point of relief, no nearer to the hole.
8. Providing Relief from Animal Hoof Damage: (Rule 25.1 Abnormal Ground Conditions) Other than on the putting green, damage that is clearly identifiable as having been caused by animal hoofs is ground under repair (Rule 25-1 applies). Such damage on the putting green may be repaired (Rule 25-1 does not apply). Damage that is clearly identifiable as having been caused by animal hoofs in a bunker is also deemed as ground under repair as it pertains to lie and intended line of play and not stance. Player may take relief by dropping within one club-length of and not nearer the hole than the nearest point of relief and must stay within the bunker.
9. A ball coming to rest on or near a drip-irrigation outlet, where interference with the swing will occur, allows for relief without penalty.
10. Slow play is unacceptable; keep pace with the group ahead of you.
11. Keep carts on paths around tees, greens and bunkers; use 90° rule when possible.
