

U.S.G.A. RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY
PLEASE ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING LOCAL RULES

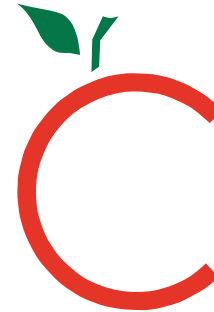
1. Out-of-Bounds is defined by white stakes and curbs. Note: A ball that crosses a public road is defined as out-of-bounds even though it may come to rest on another part of the course.
2. Penalty Areas are defined by red stakes and lines. Drop areas are provided on holes 3 and 13.
3. Before playing your ball in a bunker, you may remove loose impediments and movable obstructions.
4. Embedded ball rule is in effect "through the green."

COURSE INFORMATION AND ETIQUETTE

1. Hole locations follow "A," "B" or "C" rotation.
2. Yardage markers are measured to the center of the greens.
3. Please repair ball marks on greens, rake bunkers and fill divots with sand/seed.
4. Please keep pace with the group in front of you. Our pace of play expectation is four hours or less.
